1 WHEREAS, F. J. Scott Elementary School in Roma has been named
2 a National Title 1 Distinguished School by the Texas Education
3 Agency; and

4 WHEREAS, Since 1996, the National Title 1 Distinguished
5 Schools program has recognized campuses for documented student
6 achievement gains; each state education department selects just two
7 schools annually to receive this prestigious accolade; and

8 WHEREAS, F. J. Scott Elementary has strengthened its programs
9 by encouraging parents and other community members to play an
10 integral role in the life of the school; the faculty,
11 administration, and staff work diligently to provide a safe,
12 positive, and nurturing environment that maximizes opportunities
13 for learning; and

14 WHEREAS, Under the leadership of principal Diana Salinas, the
15 faculty embraces campus-wide accountability and engages in
16 vertical team building, which has strengthened the level of
17 cooperation across grade levels; weekly Professional Learning
18 Community Sessions improve teacher effectiveness by promoting
19 self-reflection, fostering a collaborative culture, and
20 strengthening the focus on academic results; and

22 designated as a 2015 National Blue Ribbon School by the U.S.
