1 WHEREAS, The tragic loss of Terry Glenn Bailey, 54, and his
2 wife, Pamela Hitt Bailey, 57, of Center on February 15, 2017, has
3 deeply saddened their family and friends and the many people in
4 their community whose lives they touched; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in Center on March 13, 1962, Terry Bailey was
6 the son of Millard and Charlotte Bailey; a self-made businessman,
7 he found success in the logging and oil industries and went on to
8 establish and own a multitude of different companies over the
9 course of his lifetime; and

10 WHEREAS, The former Pamela Hitt was born on August 26, 1959,
11 to Charles and Ann Hitt, and she graduated from Stephen F. Austin
12 State University with a degree in business; after marrying Terry
13 Bailey on September 27, 1980, she became the anchor of their
14 treasured family, which grew to include two children, Carmen and
15 Dustin, and four grandchildren, Falon, Ivy, Trevor, and Taygan; and

16 WHEREAS, This devoted husband and wife were ideal partners,
17 and together, they invested in their community by turning over
18 start-up businesses to budding entrepreneurs and purchasing land to
19 build schools and churches; they were also the owners of a deer
20 breeding facility in Center, and as lifetime members of the Texas
21 Deer Association, they forged numerous friendships and made vital
22 contributions to the deer industry across the country; with
23 Mr. Bailey's larger-than-life personality and Mrs. Bailey's innate
24 kindness, they shared a natural ability to uplift and inspire

1 others, and they thrived on the joy of having a close-knit family
2 and a wealth of cherished friends and colleagues; and

3 WHEREAS, Although tragedy has brought an untimely end to the
4 lives of these two beloved Texans, Terry and Pam Bailey leave behind
5 a legacy of dedication to their family and their community that will
6 be remembered and admired for many years to come; now, therefore, be

9 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the lives of Terry and Pamela
