WHEREAS, Born on December 30, 1952, Robert Cheshire was the 4 5 son of Marvin and Nadine Yearta Cheshire; he graduated from Victoria High School in 1970, and he earned his bachelor's degree in 6 history from The University of Texas at Austin in 1972, at the age 7 of 19; in 1977, he received his doctor of jurisprudence degree with 8 9 honors from the University of Houston Law School, and he subsequently worked for 10 years as an attorney in private 10 11 practice; and

12 WHEREAS, Robert Cheshire was appointed by Governor Bill Clements to preside over the newly created 377th District Court in 13 14 Victoria in 1989; during his 25 years on the bench, he established a reputation for integrity and impartiality, and he was noted for his 15 16 tireless work ethic; a lifelong student of the law, he enjoyed researching opinions from state and federal courts, and his 17 colleagues in the legal profession frequently sought his advice and 18 mentorship; and 19

20 WHEREAS, Selfless in his commitment to others, Judge Cheshire 21 volunteered his time with the Victoria Jaycees and the Rotary Club 22 and also served as superintendent of the Victoria Livestock Show; 23 after retiring in 2014, he elected to take senior judge status and 24 continued hearing cases in the Victoria area and other South Texas
