- 1 WHEREAS, Faculty, students, staff, and alumni are
- 2 celebrating the 100th anniversary of the establishment of Sul Ross
- 3 State University in April 2017; and
- WHEREAS, On April 4, 1917, Governor James E. Ferguson signed
- 5 a bill of the 35th Texas Legislature that established a teaching
- 6 college in the Big Bend region of West Texas; the new school was
- 7 named for Lawrence Sullivan Ross, who served as governor of Texas
- 8 from 1887 to 1891 and as president of what is now Texas A&M
- 9 University from 1891 to 1898; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Sul Ross Normal College began operations on June 14,
- 11 1920, in Alpine, where the residents provided the land, water, and
- 12 utilities for the college, as well as housing for its earliest
- 13 students; with the opening of the Museum of the Big Bend in the
- 14 1930s, the institution quickly became a cultural and educational
- 15 center for the region; in 1948, it served as the birthplace of the
- 16 National Intercollegiate Rodeo Association; and
- WHEREAS, Sul Ross attained university status in 1969, and in
- 18 1985, it joined with Southwest Texas Junior College to establish
- 19 upper-level and graduate study centers in Del Rio, Uvalde, and
- 20 Eagle Pass; another center was opened in Castroville in 2015; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Today, SRSU is a well-respected regional
- 22 comprehensive university that boasts an average enrollment of 2,000
- 23 students and offers 25 undergraduate and 22 graduate degree
- 24 programs; blessed with a learning environment that includes such

- 1 resources as Big Bend National Park, Fort Davis State Park, the Rio
- 2 Grande, and the Guadalupe Mountains, it is among the most
- 3 affordable public universities in Texas, and its gifted faculty
- 4 have made significant contributions in such disciplines as natural
- 5 resource management, history, theater, biology, and geology; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Among the school's 29,000 graduates to date are such
- 7 notable alumni as baseball great Norm Cash, of the Detroit Tigers;
- 8 the actor Dan Blocker, a star of the television classic Bonanza;
- 9 Olympic volleyball athlete Marilyn Nolen; and former Texas state
- 10 representative and U.S. congressman Pete Gallego; and
- 11 WHEREAS, For 100 years, this dynamic university has helped
- 12 thousands of Texans to achieve prosperous careers and fulfilling
- 13 lives by empowering them to take on the challenges and
- 14 opportunities that await them; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 16 Legislature hereby recognize April 4, 2017, as Sul Ross State
- 17 University Day at the State Capitol and extend to all those
- 18 associated with the school sincere best wishes for a memorable and
- 19 meaningful centennial celebration; and, be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 21 prepared for Sul Ross State University as an expression of high
- 22 regard by the Texas House of Representatives.
