R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, In recognition of her military service during World
2 War II, Alice Porter is being presented with a Women in History
3 award by the Corpus Christi Chapter of the National Society
4 Daughters of the American Revolution on March 24, 2017; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of New Jersey, Alice Porter joined the navy
6 as part of the Women Accepted for Volunteer Emergency Service
7 program in 1945; she was assigned to Naval Air Station Atlanta,
8 where she was trained as an instructor for a flight simulation
9 device called a link trainer; she was later transferred to the base
10 in Corpus Christi to teach pilots how to fly by instruments at night
11 and in unfamiliar territory; and

12 WHEREAS, Americans owe a debt of gratitude to those men and
13 women who commit themselves to defending the nation's liberty and
14 security, and Alice Porter may indeed take great pride in her
15 outstanding service to her nation; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
17 Legislature hereby congratulate Alice Porter on her receipt of a
18 Women in History award from the Corpus Christi Chapter of the
19 National Society Daughters of the American Revolution and extend to
20 her sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
