1 WHEREAS, Members of the Tyler County Country Church in
2 Woodville celebrated the grand opening of the church's new building
3 at a banquet on March 10, 2017; and

4 WHEREAS, This notable house of worship was originally
5 established as the Tyler County Cowboy Church in October 2013,
6 under the leadership of pastor Jordan Wilson; since that time, the
7 congregation has grown significantly and now consists of some 275
8 members; and

9 WHEREAS, The new 16,000-square-foot structure is the latest
10 addition to the church's property, which features multiple
11 buildings situated on 28 acres of land; the construction of the
12 facility was made possible not only by the generosity of the
13 church's congregants but also by contributions made from numerous
14 area churches; the sanctuary hosted its inaugural service on March
15 12; and

16 WHEREAS, The Tyler County Country Church has served as a
17 source of inspiration and guidance to many Woodville residents who
18 seek a full and meaningful spiritual life, and it is a privilege to
19 recognize the continuing commitment of this congregation to its
20 faith and to the wider community; now, therefore, be it
