R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Family and friends are mourning the untimely loss of  
2 Christopher Nicol McGowen, who died on March 2, 2017, at the age of  
3 47; and

4           WHEREAS, Chris McGowen was born in Wiesbaden, Germany, on  
5 April 2, 1969, to Olene and John McGowen; he was interested in  
6 politics from an early age and served in student government and  
7 other groups while attending S. R. Butler High School in  
8 Huntsville, Alabama, and while earning his bachelor's degree in  
9 communications at Auburn University; and

10           WHEREAS, In 1992, Mr. McGowen moved to Washington, D.C.,  
11 where he worked for the *Booknotes* program on C-SPAN and then served  
12 as a congressional staffer, including a stint as deputy press  
13 secretary to former U.S. representative J. C. Watts of Oklahoma;  
14 in 1996, he joined his father in a business venture affiliated with  
15 the Atlanta Olympics, and he later worked in communications in  
16 Atlanta for Cohn & Wolfe, Turner, and the Georgia Chamber of  
17 Commerce, among others; in 2004, he returned to Washington, D.C.,  
18 where he worked in government affairs for Novo Nordisk, Omada  
19 Health, and the Insulet Corporation; and

20           WHEREAS, Mr. McGowen made friends readily and maintained  
21 many friendships throughout his life; he also pursued innumerable  
22 interests, including stylish clothing, military history, college  
23 football, fishing, and grilling; a man of strong religious faith,  
24 he was a valued member of Center Grove United Methodist Church in

1 Huntsville; and

2           WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. McGowen enjoyed the love  
3 and support of his wife, Kristi Barksdale; and

4           WHEREAS, Although his days were far too few, Chris McGowen  
5 embraced life to the fullest, and he will forever remain a vibrant  
6 presence for those who knew and loved him; now, therefore, be it

7           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas  
8 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Christopher Nicol  
9 McGowen and extend heartfelt sympathy to the members of his family:  
10 to his wife, Kristi; to his mother, Olene McGowen; to his brother,  
11 Carl McGowen; to his parents-in-law, Bob and Carol Barksdale; to  
12 his sister-in-law, Erin Terry, and her husband, Dedric; and to his
