- 1 WHEREAS, A life marked by tremendous courage and resolve came 2 to an untimely end with the passing of William Dowling, a former
- 3 captain in the Houston Fire Department, on March 7, 2017, at the age
- 4 of 43; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Born in Albuquerque, New Mexico, on March 14, 1973,
- 6 Bill Dowling was the son of Mary and Rick Dowling; he moved with his
- 7 family to Texas in his youth and graduated from Klein Oak High
- 8 School in Spring in 1993; after joining the United States Marine
- 9 Corps, he advanced to the rank of corporal and served in a number of
- 10 locations, including Somalia, Bahrain, and Saudi Arabia; his
- 11 military awards included a Combat Action Ribbon, a Good Conduct
- 12 Medal, a Marine Corps Expeditionary Medal, a National Defense
- 13 Service Medal, a Southwest Asia Service Medal, and a Sea Service
- 14 Deployment Ribbon; and
- WHEREAS, Imbued with a passion for public service, Bill
- 16 Dowling pursued a career as a firefighter after returning to
- 17 civilian life; he joined the Champions Fire Department and then, in
- 18 2000, the Houston Fire Department, where he rose through the ranks
- 19 while working in some of the city's busiest stations; his years on
- 20 the job were made all the more fulfilling by the strong bond of
- 21 camaraderie that he shared with his brothers and sisters in
- 22 uniform; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Captain Dowling demonstrated the true depth of his
- 24 commitment to duty as one of the first responders who were called to

- 1 battle a massive five-alarm fire at the Southwest Inn on May 31,
- 2 2013, the deadliest day in the history of the Houston Fire
- 3 Department; when the roof of the hotel collapsed, he lost four of
- 4 his comrades and sustained life-altering injuries, which forced him
- 5 to retire from the career he loved; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This inspiring Texan earned the nickname "Iron Bill"
- 7 during his long, valiant effort to recover in the four years after
- 8 he left the department; he drew comfort and encouragement from the
- 9 love of his wife of 23 years, Jacki, and their treasured children,
- 10 Forrest, Faith, and Foster; in the course of his struggles, his
- 11 faith became a guiding light, and he took pride in having read every
- 12 page of the Bible; and
- WHEREAS, Captain Bill Dowling found his purpose in serving a
- 14 cause greater than himself, and when tragedy cast a shadow over his
- 15 future, his determination and bravery in fighting back captured the
- 16 hearts of countless people; he will be greatly missed by his family,
- 17 friends, and former colleagues, who will never forget his sacrifice
- 18 or the extraordinary strength of character that defined his life;

- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 21 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of William Dowling and
- 22 extend sincere condolences to all those who mourn his passing; and,
