1 WHEREAS, Members of the Texas Department of Public Safety

5 troopers, agents, rangers, officers, communications personnel, and
6 forensic scientists of the DPS; one of the largest organizations
7 representing law enforcement officers in the state, it boasts over

11 Foundation, which provides DPS personnel with education and

18 conducts residential telemarketing; and

22 State by improving the general welfare of DPS personnel; now,
