1           WHEREAS, Ulrich Intermediate School in Klein has been named  
2 the winner of the 2017 Great Reading Games, an annual competition  
3 sponsored by Learning Ally; and

4           WHEREAS, Learning Ally is a nonprofit organization that  
5 provides educational materials for students with print  
6 disabilities, including dyslexia, blindness, and visual  
7 impairment, at approximately 10,000 schools; the Great Reading  
8 Games contest is designed to motivate these students to spend more  
9 time reading and to engage with texts above their grade level, and  
10 during this year's competition, participants completed more than  
11 five million pages total; and

12           WHEREAS, Ulrich Intermediate beat out schools from across the  
13 country to capture first place in the 2017 Great Reading Games; all  
14 of the sixth, seventh, and eighth graders involved in the school's  
15 Learning Ally program took part in the challenge, earning a winning  
16 score of 1,580,614; and

17           WHEREAS, With their fine performance in the Great Reading  
18 Games, these outstanding young Texans have brought credit to their  
19 school, and they may take justifiable pride in the considerable  
20 skill and perseverance they have demonstrated; now, therefore, be
