2 in Corpus Christi, joined with a group of his classmates to win the
3 high school category at the regional Science Bowl competition held
4 at The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley on February 4, 2017;

6 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy Office of
7 Science, the Science Bowl brings together middle and high school
8 students to participate in a fast-paced academic contest that
9 touches on disciplines ranging from biology and chemistry to
10 physics and math; at the regional level, competitors from King High
11 School bested 19 other teams from South Texas to earn an
12 all-expenses paid trip to Washington, D.C., where they will take
13 part in the national competition being held from April 27 to May 1,
14 2017; and

15 WHEREAS, Samuel Brehm is a senior at Richard King High
16 School, where he has distinguished himself by playing with the
17 Mighty Mustang band and competing in UIL academic events, in Quiz
18 Bowl, and on the KEDT-TV program *Challenge!*; 1 of only 18 students
19 in the world to have recorded a perfect score on the 2016 Advanced
20 Placement Calculus AB test, he is also an Eagle Scout and a soloist
21 for the Corpus Christi Ballet Company; he plans to attend Rice
22 University in the fall of 2017; and

23 WHEREAS, With their fine showing in the regional Science Bowl
24 competition, the members of the King High School team have brought

1 credit to their school and their community, and Samuel Brehm may
2 take justifiable pride in his contributions to the team's winning
3 performance; now, therefore, be it

5 Legislature hereby congratulate Samuel Brehm on being part of the
6 2017 regional Science Bowl high school championship team from
7 Richard King High School and extend to him sincere best wishes for
