R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Hunter Adams, a student at Richard King High School
2 in Corpus Christi, joined with a group of his classmates to win the
3 high school category at the regional Science Bowl competition held
4 at The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley on February 4, 2017;

6 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy Office of
7 Science, the Science Bowl brings together middle and high school
8 students to participate in a fast-paced academic contest that
9 touches on disciplines ranging from biology and chemistry to
10 physics and math; at the regional level, competitors from King High
11 School bested 19 other teams from South Texas to earn an
12 all-expenses paid trip to Washington, D.C., where they will take
13 part in the national competition being held from April 27 to May 1,
14 2017; and

15 WHEREAS, Currently a senior at Richard King High School,
16 Hunter Adams has twice qualified for the Science Bowl nationals,
17 and this year, he was in charge of studying earth science for his
18 team; he is also an Eagle Scout, and as a member of his school's
19 speech and debate team, he has advanced to the national tournament
20 on two occasions; this coming fall semester, he will be attending
21 Rice University, where he plans to study both geology and theology
22 in preparation for a life in the priesthood; and

23 WHEREAS, With their fine showing in the regional Science Bowl
24 competition, the members of the King High School team have brought

1 credit to their school and their community, and Hunter Adams may
2 take justifiable pride in his contributions to the team's winning
3 performance; now, therefore, be it
