1           WHEREAS, William Johnson, a teacher at Richard King High  
2 School in Corpus Christi, coached the Science Bowl team that won the  
3 high school category at the regional competition held at The  
4 University of Texas Rio Grande Valley on February 4, 2017; and

5           WHEREAS, Sponsored by the U.S. Department of Energy Office of  
6 Science, the Science Bowl brings together middle and high school  
7 students to participate in a fast-paced academic contest that  
8 touches on disciplines ranging from biology and chemistry to  
9 physics and math; at the regional level, competitors from King High  
10 School bested 19 other teams from South Texas to earn an  
11 all-expenses paid trip to Washington, D.C., where they will take  
12 part in the national competition being held from April 27 to May 1,  
13 2017; and

14           WHEREAS, In addition to leading the King High School Science  
15 Bowl team, Mr. Johnson teaches physics and coaches the junior  
16 varsity girls' basketball team; he is an alumnus of Texas A&M  
17 University--Corpus Christi, where he earned a bachelor's degree in  
18 biomedical science; and

19           WHEREAS, With their fine showing in the regional Science Bowl  
20 competition, the members of the winning King High School team have  
21 brought credit to their school and their community, and William  
22 Johnson may take justifiable pride in his role as the team's coach;
