R E S O L U T I O N

2 School in Corpus Christi, joined with a group of his classmates to  
3 win the high school category at the regional Science Bowl  
4 competition held at The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley on  
5 February 4, 2017; and

7 Science, the Science Bowl brings together middle and high school  
8 students to participate in a fast-paced academic contest that  
9 touches on disciplines ranging from biology and chemistry to  
10 physics and math; at the regional level, competitors from King High  
11 School bested 19 other teams from South Texas to earn an  
12 all-expenses paid trip to Washington, D.C., where they will take  
13 part in the national competition being held from April 27 to May 1,  
14 2017; and

17 Interscholastic League academic contests; currently in his junior  
18 year, he has further distinguished himself as a competitive tennis
