1           WHEREAS, Harriet Davis of Girl Scout Troop No. 6839 has  
2 attained the Girl Scout Gold Award, and this accomplishment truly  
3 merits recognition; and

4           WHEREAS, To earn this distinction, Ms. Davis successfully  
5 met a series of requirements emphasizing community service,  
6 personal and spiritual growth, positive values, and leadership  
7 skills; as part of that process, she planned and implemented a Gold  
8 Award project that involved installing a little free library on  
9 each of three campuses in the Lubbock Independent School District;
