1 WHEREAS, Texans everywhere are indebted to the men and women
2 of the law enforcement profession, for by their selfless devotion

6 granted by the public they so faithfully serve, these gallant
7 individuals daily risk their lives in order to ensure domestic

9 WHEREAS, Detention Officer Tronoski D. Jones of the Harris
10 County Sheriff's Office exemplified in his personal and
11 professional conduct the singular virtues of courage, integrity,
12 and steadfast resolve, and throughout his three years, nine months
13 on the force, his meritorious service embodied the highest ideals

15 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan, who died on August 20, 2015,
16 following an altercation with an inmate, will long be missed by his
17 family, his fellow peace officers, and the entire community; and

18 WHEREAS, Though his life ended far too soon, Officer Jones
19 has left behind a record of public service that is deserving of his
20 fellow citizens' lasting respect and gratitude; now, therefore, be
