10 of Public Safety exemplified in his personal and professional

15 WHEREAS, Killed in the line of duty on March 26, 2016, Trooper
16 Nichols will long be missed by his family, his fellow peace

20 fellow citizens' lasting respect and gratitude; now, therefore, be
