10 Department exemplified in his personal and professional conduct the
11 singular virtues of courage, integrity, and steadfast resolve, and
12 throughout his 14 years, 6 months on the force, his meritorious
13 service embodied the highest ideals of his vocation; and

14 WHEREAS, Killed in the line of duty on July 8, 2016, Corporal
15 Ahrens will long be missed by his family, his fellow peace officers,
16 and the entire community; and

17 WHEREAS, Though his life ended far too soon, Corporal Ahrens
18 left behind a record of public service that is deserving of his
19 fellow citizens' lasting respect and gratitude; now, therefore, be
