

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Some of the many obstacles overcome by Caren Bright
2 of Dallas inspired her to found Pamper Lake Highlands, an
3 organization dedicated to breaking the cycle of generational
4 poverty for women and children; and

5 WHEREAS, After a childhood beset with hardship, Ms. Bright
6 found herself in a situation of extreme poverty as a young adult;
7 however, with the help of her neighbors and friends, she was able to
8 earn her GED, take community college classes, and provide a
9 brighter future for her own children; and

10 WHEREAS, In 2014, Ms. Bright decided to support other mothers
11 facing financial difficulties by establishing Pamper Lake
12 Highlands; this notable nonprofit conducts annual diaper drives,
13 the most recent of which collected more than 72,000 diapers for
14 distribution to families in need; because Ms. Bright credits her
15 success to five key elements--education, counseling, parenting
16 classes, Bible study, and addiction recovery--her organization
17 offers a variety of courses in these areas; as long as the 80 women
18 currently served by the organization attend classes, they receive
19 free diapers for their children, as well as curriculum-based child
20 care; and

21 WHEREAS, Caren Bright serves as a remarkable example of
22 generosity, fortitude, and perseverance, and she is indeed
23 deserving of recognition for her outstanding contributions to the
24 Dallas community; now, therefore, be it
