1 WHEREAS, The heroic military service of Ram Chavez was 2 recognized by Alaniz-Valentine Chapter 598 of the Military Order of 3 the Purple Heart at a ceremony aboard the USS *Lexington* in Corpus 4 Christi on February 28, 2017; and

5 WHEREAS, One of our nation's highest military commendations, 6 the Purple Heart is awarded to members of the U.S. armed forces who 7 have been wounded or killed in combat; the Military Order of the 8 Purple Heart is a veterans organization founded in 1932 that draws 9 its membership from individuals who have received the medal; and

10 WHEREAS, Purple Heart recipient Ram Chavez served his nation 11 in Vietnam as a member of the U.S. Army, and he was wounded in action 12 on May 6, 1968; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Chavez was one of 16 living Purple Heart recipients who were recognized at the ceremony in Corpus Christi, along with two others who lost their lives in the line of duty; among those paying tribute to the honorees were Brigadier General James Mobley, Vietnam veteran J. R. Pena, and the color guard of the W. B. Ray High School Naval Junior ROTC; and

WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to Ram Chavez for putting himself in harm's way to defend our freedom, and his selfless efforts are a source of inspiration for all who know him; now, therefore, be it
