

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The heroic military service of Ysrael Ramirez was  
2 recognized by Alaniz-Valentine Chapter 598 of the Military Order of  
3 the Purple Heart at a ceremony aboard the USS *Lexington* in Corpus  
4 Christi on February 28, 2017; and

5           WHEREAS, One of our nation's highest military commendations,  
6 the Purple Heart is awarded to members of the U.S. armed forces who  
7 have been wounded or killed in combat; the Military Order of the  
8 Purple Heart is a veterans organization founded in 1932 that draws  
9 its membership from individuals who have received the medal; and

10           WHEREAS, Purple Heart recipient Ysrael Ramirez served his  
11 nation in Vietnam as a member of the U.S. Army, and he was wounded in  
12 action in May 1970; and

13           WHEREAS, Mr. Ramirez was one of 16 living Purple Heart  
14 recipients who were recognized at the ceremony in Corpus Christi,  
15 along with two others who lost their lives in the line of duty;  
16 among those paying tribute to the honorees were Brigadier General  
17 James Mobley, Vietnam veteran J. R. Pena, and the color guard of the  
18 W. B. Ray High School Naval Junior ROTC; and

19           WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to Ysrael  
20 Ramirez for putting himself in harm's way to defend our freedom, and  
21 his selfless efforts are a source of inspiration for all who know  
22 him; now, therefore, be it

23           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas  
24 Legislature hereby honor Ysrael Ramirez on the occasion of his

1 recognition by Alaniz-Valentine Chapter 598 of the Military Order  
2 of the Purple Heart and commend him for his sacrifice in behalf of  
3 our nation; and, be it further

4       RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be

6 Texas House of Representatives.
