7 WHEREAS, In 2008, Mr. Miller was tapped to serve as head 8 coach of the Sam Houston State University rodeo team; just three years later, the men's rodeo team won the national championship, 9 10 and the women's team was named reserve national champions; he has also worked with many nationally recognized students and rodeo 11 teams; in all his endeavors, he is blessed with the love of a fine 12 family, which in addition to his wife includes his two treasured 13 14 children, Bradlee and Sonilyn; and
