1 WHEREAS, Gaylon Clark, pastor of Greater Mount Zion Baptist
2 Church in Austin, is serving as Pastor of the Day for the Texas
3 House of Representatives on May 23, 2017; and

5 studies from Dallas Baptist University in 1989, and he went on to
6 receive a master's degree in theology, with an emphasis in pastoral
7 ministries, from Dallas Theological Seminary in 1996; and

9 served as the lead pastor of Greater Mount Zion Baptist Church, and
