RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Proud residents of Kennedale are gathering in Austin 1 2 to celebrate Kennedale Day at the State Capitol on March 30, 2017; 3 and WHEREAS, Set among the rolling grasslands of southeast 4 Tarrant County, the site of Kennedale was originally inhabited by Native American tribes who hunted and fished along Village Creek; 6 7 the Republic of Texas signed a treaty with the tribes in 1843, and settlers began moving into the area over the following decades; and 8 9 WHEREAS, In 1882, John D. Hudson, C. B. Teague, and Oliver S. Kennedy bought land around a mineral well; a post office was 10 opened on the land two years later, and in 1886, a town was laid out 11 12 and named Kennedale, after Mr. Kennedy; that same year, the Fort Worth and New Orleans Railway Company built a line through the town 13 14 to connect Fort Worth and Waxahachie, along with a passenger depot and several section houses as residences for its employees; during 15 16 that era, the town became known for its brickworks, and Kennedale brick was used in several structures in Fort Worth; and 17 WHEREAS, A town that has grown into a city since the regional 18 defense industry buildup of the 1940s, Kennedale today is an 19 20 attractive and comfortable community of approximately 8,000 people who enjoy easy access to the amenities of Fort Worth and Arlington; 21 residents and visitors alike appreciate the opportunities for 22 23 recreation available at Rodgers Farm Park and Sonora Park, and a replica of one of the original railway section houses stands at 24
