R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Members of Cooke County Republican Women are
2 gathering in Austin for the Texas Federation of Republican Women's
3 Texas Legislative Day at the State Capitol on April 6, 2017; and

4 WHEREAS, Cooke County Republican Women was established on
5 October 21, 1991, by 10 founding members; with the guidance of
6 Marcia Saunders, a leader in the Texas Federation of Republican
7 Women, CCRW began a long-term grassroots effort to advance the

9 initiatives, from volunteering for phone banks and block walking to
