R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Public-spirited citizens from across the Lone Star
2 State are gathering in Austin on April 10, 2017, to advocate for
3 women and their families during Blue Ribbon Lobby Day at the
4 Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, Led by organizers Carol Jablonski, president of
6 Texas Democratic Women, Tammie Hartgroves, past president of Texas
7 Democratic Women, and Crystal Perkins, executive director of the
8 Texas Democratic Party, and joined by concerned women and leaders
9 from around the state, Blue Ribbon Lobby Day provides an occasion on
10 which to bring attention to issues important to Texas women,
11 including public education, health care, and immigration; and

12 WHEREAS, During this day of action, Democratic women are
13 meeting with legislators to discuss the need for ensuring that
14 women have equal opportunities and that their rights are equally
15 protected in order that Texas' prosperity may continue; and
