

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Odessa College has been named the recipient of a
2 2017 Rising Star award by the Aspen Institute; and

3 WHEREAS, The Rising Star award recognizes public community
4 colleges across the country for exceptional achievement, measured
5 by outcomes in student learning, certificate and degree completion,
6 employment and earnings, and high levels of access and success for
7 minority and low-income students; the honor brings a monetary prize
8 of \$100,000 to further advance the school's mission; and

9 WHEREAS, Many positive factors contributed to the selection
10 of Odessa College; the school increased its annual
11 graduation-transfer rates from 15 percent to 32 percent in just
12 four years, and it maintained a course withdrawal rate of only 1.8
13 percent; five years after graduating, members of the Class of 2010
14 earned more than double the wages of all other workers in the
15 region; moreover, OC prides itself on the cultural diversity of its
16 campus population; and

17 WHEREAS, Open access and affordability make community
18 colleges a vital component of higher education, and through its
19 long-standing commitment to excellence, Odessa College has
20 distinguished itself as a resource of immeasurable value to West
21 Texas and beyond; now, therefore, be it

23 Legislature hereby congratulate Odessa College on its receipt of a
24 Rising Star award from the Aspen Institute and extend to the
