1 WHEREAS, The Port Aransas Independent School District has

4 WHEREAS, Furthering the district's reputation for academic
5 excellence, Ancel Brundrett Middle School was recognized by the
6 Texas Education Agency as a High-Performing School during the
7 2015-2016 academic year, while H. G. Olsen Elementary School was
8 designated as a High-Progress Federal Reward School; in addition,
9 two teams from Port Aransas High School qualified for the
10 University Interscholastic League State Cross-Examination Debate
11 tournament, and two PAHS students were named 2016 Corpus Christi
12 Caller-Times/Citgo South Texas Distinguished Scholars; and

14 their district in the arts; in conjunction with the Port Aransas
15 Community Theater, young performers took part in productions of *Elf*

21 2016, the softball and boys' basketball teams clinched district
22 championships, and members of the boys' and girls' cross-country
23 teams qualified for the state meet for the second consecutive year;
24 moreover, both the Marlins and Lady Marlins basketball teams were

1 regional semifinalists in 2017; and

3 Aransas Independent School District have demonstrated an
4 exceptional commitment to helping young Texans build a strong
5 foundation for the future, and their efforts have been reflected in
6 the many significant achievements of the students in the district;
