## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The observance of Texas Missing Persons Day on April
- 2 26, 2017, provides an opportunity to raise awareness of the many
- 3 individuals of all ages who go missing each year; and
- 4 WHEREAS, In 2015, the National Crime Information Center
- 5 recorded nearly 58,000 cases of missing Texans, a figure that
- 6 includes more than 11,500 adults and 46,000 children; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The establishment of Texas Missing Persons Day is
- 8 due in part to the efforts of Jo Ann Lowitzer, whose daughter,
- 9 Alexandria Joy "Ali" Lowitzer, went missing from Spring on April
- 10 26, 2010, at the age of 16; on the anniversary of that tragic day,
- 11 communities are encouraged to come together in support of all
- 12 families who have suffered the disappearance of a loved one; this
- 13 occasion also offers an opportunity to educate those families on
- 14 the best way to aid in the investigation of their loved one's case,
- 15 to communicate with case investigators, and to maintain public
- 16 awareness of the case until it is resolved; and
- 17 WHEREAS, No matter their age, all missing persons leave
- 18 behind family and friends whose lives are consumed with longing for
- 19 their safe return, and it is appropriate that a special day be set
- 20 aside in honor of all those who have disappeared; now, therefore, be
- 21 it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 23 Legislature hereby recognize April 26, 2017, as Texas Missing
- 24 Persons Day.
