4 show tested the baking skills of 10 contestants between the ages of
5 10 and 13 in a series of challenges spanning eight episodes; and

6 WHEREAS, Demonstrating exceptional skill, Rebecca Beale
7 advanced through the competition to the final round, where she and
8 two other contestants were required to create a cake with at least
9 two layers that fit the "Spring Break Cakes" theme; she impressed
10 the judges by making a colorful three-tier, 12-layer strawberry and
11 lemon cake complete with surfboards, shark fins, and other
12 beach-themed decorations; when the votes were tallied, Rebecca was
13 named the winner, taking home the \$25,000 prize; and

15 showing off her talents in the kitchen but also delights in hunting,
16 fishing, and competitive cheerleading; moreover, she has served as
17 student council president at Graham Junior High School and as a
