RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Members of First Methodist Church of Chillicothe 2 gathered on May 21, 2016, to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the 3 construction of their church; and

WHEREAS, Organized in 1886 in the Jackson Springs community, 4 5 the congregation was served in its early days by circuit riders C. T. Neese and J. T. Hosmer; the church was relocated 6 to 7 Chillicothe not long after the Fort Worth and Denver City Railway reached the town in the following year; eventually, the 8 9 congregation found a new site, and prominent architect Rockwell Henry Stuckey was hired to design a building, which was completed in 10 11 1916; and

WHEREAS, The church's classical elements include a cornice, columns, and eaves, and it also features an octagonal dome and stained glass windows that were crafted in Germany; in 1998, the building was designated as a Recorded Texas Historic Landmark by the Texas Historical Commission; and

WHEREAS, Countless area residents have looked to the First Methodist Church of Chillicothe for spiritual guidance for over a century, and it is a pleasure to join in honoring the church and the rich history of its venerable house of worship; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas Legislature hereby commemorate the 100th anniversary of the First Methodist Church of Chillicothe building and extend to the members
