16 School in 1997, and during his 11 seasons as head coach of the

17 Indians, he guided his teams to 8 postseason appearances and 2 trips

18 to the regional round of the UIL playoffs; he retired in 2008,

19 leaving the coaching ranks after 36 years with an impressive total

20 of 706 wins and numerous Coach of the Year accolades; and

21 WHEREAS, Widely respected by his peers, Coach Gaylor has

22 contributed to his profession through his service as a board

23 member, board secretary, and president of the Texas Association of

24 Basketball Coaches; moreover, he has regularly shared his talents
