R E S O L U T I O N

2 Gainesville has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. Hess earned the requisite 21 merit badges and

9 constructing two metal benches for the grotto behind St. Peter's

23 perseverance in achieving his goals have proven him worthy to stand
24 among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a
