R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Throckmorton High School senior Peyton Woods has  
2 helped to preserve an important facet of local history by producing  
3 a supplemental workbook for the Throckmorton Independent School  
4 District; and

5           WHEREAS, Mr. Woods began this project after discovering that  
6 the pre-Civil War military outpost Camp Cooper in Throckmorton  
7 County was publicly inaccessible and thus ineligible for  
8 registration with the Texas Heritage Trails Program; after  
9 performing extensive research on the historical site, he created  
10 junior high-level study material to supplement the district's Texas  
11 history curriculum, and soon thereafter, his work was approved for  
12 use by the Throckmorton ISD Board of Trustees; he also donated 20  
13 books, many signed by the authors, relating to county history to the  
14 school library; and

15           WHEREAS, The Throckmorton Chamber of Commerce has committed  
16 to having 25 copies of the material professionally bound and  
17 donated to the local school system and the area homeschooling  
18 cooperative; Mr. Woods is currently using the curriculum to compete  
19 in Leadership TMCN, a scholarship program administered by the Texas  
20 Midwest Community Network; and

21           WHEREAS, This notable young Texan has distinguished himself  
22 through his efforts in behalf of Throckmorton ISD, and he may indeed  
23 take great pride in knowing that his work will help local students  
24 learn about the rich history of their county for years to come; now,

1 therefore, be it

2           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas  
3 Legislature hereby commend Peyton Woods for contributing to the  
4 Texas history curriculum adopted by the Throckmorton Independent  
5 School District and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued  
6 success; and, be it further

7           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
8 prepared for Mr. Woods as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
9 House of Representatives.
