15 Management principles developed by Matador's owner, Charles Koch,
16 Mr. Kilmer has been a speaker for the King Ranch Institute for Ranch

19 the advancement of his profession by joining with other Matador
20 Ranch employees to assist a KRIRM graduate student with a
21 management survey of 15 of the largest ranches in the country; and
