1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the sorrow felt by 2 the loved ones of John Leonard Callan of Jacksboro, a remarkable young man whose life was cut tragically short on November 26, 2016, 3 at the age of 17; and 4 WHEREAS, Born on February 2, 1999, in Fort Worth, Johnny 5 Callan was the son of Kerri LeDoux and Joe Callan and the brother of 6 7 Grant, Beau, and Alexis; he was a senior at Jacksboro High School, where he served his peers as president of the FFA program and as 8 9 Area IV FFA president; he frequently showcased his talents in FFA competitions, contributing to the National Champion Team in the 10 11 range evaluation event and placing in various other state FFA 12 contests; named a Ford Leadership Scholar at the state level, he attended the National FFA Convention and numerous state conventions 13 14 as a voting delegate and won championship titles at livestock market goat shows across Texas; and 15 WHEREAS, A gifted and hardworking student, Mr. Callan was 16 poised to graduate as valedictorian of the Class of 2017 at his 17 school; he served as president of the student council, and he also 18 found time to participate in a host of other extracurricular 19 groups, including the Beta Club, the National Honor Society, 4-H, 20 21 and the Fellowship of Christian Athletes; dedicated to giving back to his community as well, he designed, raised funds, and personally 22 23 met with city officials to facilitate the construction of a public

lake dock, and he helped plan "Operation Restoration," a campaign
