11 pioneering project to assist destitute children in foreign

12 countries, and the program was used as a template for antipoverty

13 initiatives carried out by other Rotary Clubs; moreover, the Humble

14 Rotarians have contributed to the global polio eradication efforts

16 WHEREAS, Over the course of its history, the Rotary Club of

17 Humble has staged annual fund-raising events, including spaghetti

18 suppers, fish fries, and crawfish festivals; in the early years,

19 proceeds were donated to such recipients as the Boy Scouts, the

20 Octavia Fields Branch Library, local schools, and area Little

21 Leagues; in the past 18 years alone, the group has provided a total

22 of \$1.8 million to philanthropic causes, and among the

23 organizations that have benefited from its support are the Humble
