18 WHEREAS, Over the course of 34 years in medicine, Dr. Wright 19 established a reputation as a leader in her field and touched the 20 lives of countless people; in her free time, she pursued a wide 21 variety of interests, among them reading, bead making, knitting, 22 and playing guitar and piano, and she was a true animal lover; and

23 WHEREAS, Valerie Wright lived a rich and purposeful life 24 centered around her work and her family, and she will long be
