2 Program at Reilly Elementary School in Austin has been making a
3 positive difference in the lives of young Texans; and

4 WHEREAS, Pioneered during the 1997-1998 school year, this
5 inspiring program pairs students at Reilly Elementary with DPS
6 employees, who eat lunch and spend time with the children on a
7 weekly basis; during its first year, 10 DPS employees participated
8 in the initiative, and today more than 100 mentors volunteer their
9 time; and

11 men and women also host an annual year-end party for the students
12 and organize fund-raising events to support field trips and provide
13 school supplies, winter coats, and holiday gifts for those in need;
14 in recognition of its notable efforts, the program was awarded the
15 2014 Business Partner of the Year honor by Austin Partners in
16 Education; and

17 WHEREAS, The participants of the DPS Mentor Program at Reilly
18 Elementary have demonstrated a strong commitment to improving the
19 quality of life in their community, and their willingness to give of
20 their time and talents sets an outstanding example of civic
