15 nature in his students, he supplemented classroom instruction with

16 an annual camping trip, and many of his pupils considered him their

17 favorite teacher; he was also a special education teacher for

18 several years, serving in the Crockett and Palestine Independent

19 School Districts and in a remote Eskimo village, Akiachak, Alaska;

- 3 in the great outdoors, and he and his wife traveled to all 50

- 5 his eldest grandson, he harvested trees and built a log cabin, and
- 6 when he began growing sugarcane, he shared jars of homemade syrup
- 7 with friends, relatives, and fellow retired teachers; and

- 9 people, and those who were fortunate enough to know him will forever
