WHEREAS, The Hispanic Women's Network of Texas is marking 31
years of service in 2017; and

3 WHEREAS, The Hispanic Women's Network of Texas is a statewide 4 organization made up of individuals from diverse backgrounds who 5 share a commitment to promoting the participation of women in 6 public, corporate, and civic life; members of HWNT seek to advance 7 the educational, cultural, social, legal, and economic well-being 8 of all women while also celebrating and fostering a positive image 9 of Hispanic culture across the state; and

WHEREAS, The idea for the network originated in 1986 when several area leaders came together to discuss the need for such an organization; their efforts culminated in a 1987 conference in Dallas that drew a contingent of 200 women from every geographic area of Texas, who pledged to continue to work to address issues of import to Hispanic women; and

WHEREAS, Since the group's founding, it has supported a range 16 of important initiatives, including educational and mentoring 17 programs, the Women's Right to Vote Celebration, the Hispanic 18 Summit and Emerging Leaders Conference, the HWNT State Conference, 19 20 and various achievement awards and ceremonies; the organization now 21 has chapters in Austin, Corpus Christi, Dallas, Denton, El Paso, Fort Worth, Houston, San Antonio, the Rio Grande Valley, and South 22 23 Texas, as well as a student chapter at The University of Texas at 24 Austin; and
