

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The McKinney High School Flying Lions Rocketry Team
2 was a preliminary winner at the 2016-2017 NASA Student Launch
3 challenge in Huntsville, Alabama, which was held from April 5 to 9,
4 2017; and

5 WHEREAS, Hosted by NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center, the
6 17th annual NASA Student Launch represented the culmination of
7 eight months of teamwork by 60 middle school, high school, and
8 college-level rocketry squads from 23 states; the middle and high
9 school teams qualified for the competition by finishing among the
10 top 25 at the Team America Rocketry Challenge in Washington, D.C.,
11 and their acceptance was based on a proposal detailing their
12 rocket's design, recovery system, payload, safety measures, and
13 educational engagement plans; the Flying Lions were one of only
14 three middle and high school teams selected from Texas, and the
15 group was named the preliminary winner of the Rocket Fair Display
16 Award in its division at the Student Launch challenge; and

17 WHEREAS, With advice from engineers at Raytheon and Emerson
18 Electric, the team completed several technical design reviews via
19 videoconference with NASA engineers during the school year as the
20 students progressed through the design and build stages of their
21 project; the end result was a 10-foot-tall 50-pound rocket that can
22 reach a speed of 370 miles per hour and an altitude of one mile and
23 can land safely by parachute for reuse; and

24 WHEREAS, By creating a functional rocket in the NASA Student

1 Launch, the members of the Flying Lions have broadened their
2 knowledge in the vital areas of science, technology, engineering,
3 and math while also experiencing the rewards of meeting a
4 challenging goal, and they may indeed take pride in their
5 impressive achievement; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
7 Legislature hereby congratulate the McKinney High School Flying
8 Lions Rocketry Team on becoming the preliminary winner of the
9 Rocket Fair Display Award at the 2017 NASA Student Launch and extend
10 to the team's members sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it
11 further

13 prepared for the Flying Lions as an expression of high regard by the
14 Texas House of Representatives.
