WHEREAS, Reverend Penley served as senior 17 pastor of Ridgecrest Baptist Church in Haltom City for more than two decades, 18 until his retirement in 1997, and he went on to minister to senior 19 20 adults at Oak Knoll Baptist Church from 1999 to 2005 and at Lamar 21 Baptist Church from 2006 until 2016; he was also a pastoral counselor at Haltom Road Baptist Church and a substitute teacher 22 23 for the Birdville Independent School District; and
