- WHEREAS, Starting in 1992, Mr. Mattax represented the Texas
- 16 Department of Insurance for many years, working with eight
- 17 insurance commissioners on a wide variety of issues; he also
- 18 represented the state banking and securities departments, as well
- 19 as other state agencies; in January 2015, he was appointed Texas
- 20 Commissioner of Insurance by Governor Greg Abbott, and in December
- 21 2016, he was elected secretary-treasurer of the National
- 22 Association of Insurance Commissioners; and
- WHEREAS, A man of great erudition, charm, and warmth,
