

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The members of the fifth class of Governor William
2 P. Clements Jr. Scholars have distinguished themselves through
3 their commitment to public service and public policy; and

4 WHEREAS, These young Texans are participating in the Clements
5 Legislative Study Program, which is hosted by the Texas
6 Conservative Coalition Research Institute; this exemplary program
7 seeks to train, support, and sustain the next generation of leaders
8 and public servants, instilling in them the values and work ethic of
9 former governor William P. Clements Jr.; and

10 WHEREAS, Governor Clements overcame the misfortunes that
11 befell his family during the Great Depression to create the world's
12 largest offshore drilling company; he won an upset victory to
13 become the state's first Republican governor since Reconstruction,
14 bringing his business acumen to state government and focusing on
15 such issues as sound budgeting, crime prevention, and economic
16 diversification; and

17 WHEREAS, The Clements Legislative Study Program is the only
18 program of its kind to bring conservative students to Austin so that
19 they may gain valuable experience in leadership and public service
