1 WHEREAS, The tragic death of Harrison Brown of Graham on May
2 1, 2017, at the age of 19, has immeasurably saddened the family,
3 friends, and fellow students of this talented and beloved young
4 man; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of Graham, Harrison Brown was the son of
6 Dr. Kurt Brown and Lori Brown, and he grew up with the companionship
7 of his brother, John; he graduated in 2016 from Graham High School,
8 where he frequently made the honor roll while also participating in
9 track, cross-country, theater, and the student council; his deepest
10 passion, however, was his love for music, and during his years at
11 Graham High, he performed in the choir and the Rompin' Stompin' Big
12 Blue Band, winning admiration for his beautiful voice and his skill
13 in playing numerous instruments; in his senior year, he received
14 more than a dozen scholarships to support his college studies; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Brown enrolled as a freshman at The University
16 of Texas at Austin in the fall of 2016, and he was an enthusiastic
17 Longhorn who wore his burnt orange with pride; he joined a
18 fraternity and an a capella singing group on the campus, and he
19 often brought smiles to his fellow residents at Jester East
20 dormitory by singing in the halls and stairwells; his innate sense
21 of joy and optimism won him the affection of many friends, and he
22 had a remarkable way of lifting the spirits of everyone around him
23 as well; and

24 WHEREAS, Although his days were far too few, Harrison Brown
