9 licensing chiropodists; and

11 Medical Association as its name in 1986; today, its membership

12 includes more than 680 doctors of podiatric medicine, or

13 podiatrists, who are uniquely qualified to diagnose and treat

14 conditions affecting the foot and ankle; the care that they provide

15 to Texas patients can reduce hospitalizations and save millions in

16 medical costs, and their services are of crucial importance to

17 diabetic patients with complications of the lower extremities; and

21 Texans, and it is a pleasure to join in recognizing this special
