1 WHEREAS, Cesar Chavez Elementary School in Fort Worth is
2 celebrating its 15th anniversary in 2017; and

3 WHEREAS, Since opening its doors in 2002, Cesar Chavez
4 Elementary has built a notable record of scholastic achievement; in
5 addition to continually meeting standards set forth by the Texas
6 Education Agency, the school earned distinction for English
7 language arts and reading in 2013 and for academic growth and
8 progress in 2014; and

9 WHEREAS, Aably guided by principal Monica Ordaz, the
10 institution is dedicated to offering students a dynamic curriculum
11 that not only prepares them for the challenges and opportunities of
12 tomorrow but also promotes creative thinking and a lifelong love of
13 learning; the school is in its second year of implementing Project
14 Lead the Way, which encourages students to develop an understanding
15 of the computer science, engineering, and biomedical science fields
16 while improving their ability to solve problems and work as part of
17 a team; moreover, Cesar Chavez is the only elementary school in the
18 Fort Worth Independent School District to include classes in
19 glasswork, ceramics, oil painting, and murals; and

20 WHEREAS, The school's faculty and staff have successfully
21 nurtured excellence in a number of extracurricular activities, with
22 many of their students garnering special recognition in the arts,
23 including placing first in the University Interscholastic League
24 music memory contest; the campus also supports three dance teams,

1 including lyrical and hip-hop, ballroom, and adult ballroom, as
2 well as a host of academic and athletic clubs; and

3 WHEREAS, For a decade and a half, Cesar Chavez Elementary has
4 provided many young Texans with a strong educational foundation,
5 and it is indeed a pleasure to honor the school on this milestone
6 occasion; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
8 Legislature hereby commemorate the 15th anniversary of Cesar Chavez
9 Elementary School and extend to its administrators, faculty, staff,
10 and students sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it
