2 director of the Rape Crisis Center in San Antonio, concluding an
3 exemplary 13 years of service to the center and its clients; and

5 Antonio, Ms. Elizondo went on to complete a master's degree in
6 psychology in 2005 at Our Lady of the Lake University; after
7 accepting an internship with the Rape Crisis Center, beginning what
8 she believed would be a temporary affiliation, she felt a calling to
9 continue her work there; she signed on as a full-time clinician, and
10 in 2007 she was named clinical director of the center; and

11 WHEREAS, Throughout her tenure, Ms. Elizondo has executed
12 her duties with skill, energy, and selfless commitment; honored by
13 Our Lady of the Lake University with the Outstanding Alumni Award,
14 she was also selected as a 2016-2017 Tesoro Leadership Fellow by the
15 San Antonio Area Foundation; and

17 contributed immeasurably to the work of the Rape Crisis Center, and
18 she may reflect with pride on all that she has accomplished as she
