1 WHEREAS, Detective Ronald L. Iscaro retired from the Dallas
2 Police Department on May 2, 2017, drawing to a close a notable
3 tenure that spanned three and a half decades; and

4 WHEREAS, Ron Iscaro joined the department as a police officer
5 on April 5, 1982, and he went on to earn promotion to detective; at
6 the time of his retirement, he was assigned to the Northeast
7 Investigative Unit; and

8 WHEREAS, A highly decorated peace officer, Mr. Iscaro was
9 accorded the Theodore Roosevelt Award and the Police Shield Award
10 after being shot while on duty in 1983, and over the years he also
11 received 19 commendations; he further distinguished himself as a
12 member of the Dallas Police Choir, singing at area nursing homes and
13 rehabilitation centers, and he plans to accompany the ensemble to
14 Washington, D.C., later this year to perform a tribute to police
15 officers killed in the line of duty; in all his endeavors, he enjoys
16 the love and support of his wife, Ann; and

17 WHEREAS, Ron Iscaro exemplified the highest ideals of the law
18 enforcement profession throughout his career, and his unwavering
19 dedication to the safety and well-being of his fellow citizens has
20 earned him the lasting respect and admiration of all who know him;
21 now, therefore, be it

23 Legislature hereby congratulate Ronald L. Iscaro on his retirement
